SACRAMENTS

You must be a registered member of St. Anthony of Padua Parish in order for the priests to administer the Sacraments of Matrimony, Baptism, and in unusual cases, Confirmation.

In addition, the administrator is required to supply an affidavit of Catholicity for those seeking to be a witness or sponsor for the sacrament of Baptism or Confirmation at a parish other than St. Anthony's.

If you are a registered member of St. Anthony of Padua, the administrator/pastor may also give you permission to be baptized or married at another parish.

The traditional method of keeping the administrator informed that you are a practicing Catholic, a member of the parish, and of the proper age requirement is through records that are on file in the Parish Office. Registration and the consistent use of envelopes verifies that you are an active parishioner who frequently attends Mass and other services.

While your contributions are important and help support our parish, the amount of your contribution does not influence the affidavit.
