## **St. Christopher Catholic School 2008-2009 School Year**

### **Admission**

Students entering kindergarten must have the age of 5 years on or before September 30<sup>th</sup>. All registrants must present an original birth certificate and a baptismal certificate if applicable at registration. All health record forms must be completed in compliance with the State of Nevada.

St. Christopher Catholic School does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, sex, national ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, admission policies, athletics and other school administered programs. If, in the opinion of the school administration, the applicant's academic or other special needs cannot be met with St. Christopher Catholic School's present available resources, the application can be denied.

Children must be able to speak English and will be required to successfully pass a placement exam.

Parents/guardians who choose to place their child (ren) in St. Christopher Catholic School make a decision that involves commitment and financial sacrifice. The education for their child (ren) is a partnership between the parents/guardians and St. Christopher Catholic School and Parish.

All new students are on probation for their first year of enrollment.

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### **St. Christopher Catholic School Categories**

**Category I:** Category I requires the parent/guardian to be an active member of St. Christopher Catholic Church and be currently tithing with them. You must be registered with St. Christopher Catholic Church at least 6 months prior to getting the parishioner rate. Parent/Guardian is responsible to bring in a current Parish Affidavit signed by the Pastor before making the first payment.

**Category II:** Category II requires the parent/guardian to be an active member of a different parish in the state of Nevada and be currently tithing with their parish. The school must have an updated Parish Affidavit signed by the Pastor before making the first payment.

**Category III:** Category III, the parent/guardian is not a catholic, is not currently registered at a parish, and is not currently tithing at a local parish in the state of Nevada.

- Legal Birth Certificate
- Updated Immunization Records
- Baptismal Certificate
- First Communion Certificate
- Current and past year's report card
- Standardized test scores
- Provide description of any special learning or physical disability
- Signed statement
- Parish Affidavit
- Application and Waiting List Fee of \$100.00 per student (will be deducted from your \$450.00)
- PR Fee \$130 must be paid by your **second payment**. This money goes toward: Parish Bazaar Raffle Tickets (\$60), PTO (\$20), and Computer Technology Fee, which will be due by Wednesday, September 10, 2008.
- Yard Duty (See below)

### **Kindergarten Rate:**

Kindergarten tuition is normally at a higher rate than the rest of the tuition. Kindergarten tuition is a separate rate and will not be combined with the tuition rate for grade(s) 1-8.

### **Returned Check Fee**

Checks returned for insufficient funds or closed accounts are assessed a \$35.00 fee. If warranted by administration, families may be required to pay cash only for the entire school year.

### **Late Fee**

St. Christopher School charges a \$10 late fee for every day that you are late for the tuition payment.

### **Yard Duty Assignments**

All families that are Virtus Trained and fingerprinted have the option to be assigned 3 hour minimum for lunch duty and playground supervision or pay \$150.00. Any families not Virtus Trained and fingerprinted will have until the beginning of May to get that taken care of. If by the end of the school year, you have not done so, \$150.00 will be charged onto your account.

Upon completing this application, you are acknowledging St. Christopher School criteria for acceptance which includes:

- Registration in parish to qualify for Category I
- Involvement within the parish and school organizations and activities
- Parental guidance of children to assure children's attendance at church, their striving for academic success, and their respectful behavior regarding St. Christopher School and Church.
